## International Umpire Fees

## 1. UMPIRE FEES

- 1.1 Fees are payable to World Sailing (WS) International Umpires who officiate at the following events:
- (a) WS Open Match Racing World Championships (currently the World Match Racing Tour);
  - (b) Open Grade 1 events; and
  - (c) Open Grade 2 to 5 events and all Women's events which have cash or cashable prizes, appearance payments, individual sponsorship payments by the event organizers or otherwise any other benefits of a similar nature totalling €15,500.
- 1.2 Fees are based on the number of racing days, plus an additional amount with respect to travel. The fees payable are below.
- 1.3 The Deputy Chief Umpire fee is only payable when the Deputy Chief Umpire is appointed by WS. If no Deputy Chief Umpire is appointed by WS, but the Chief Umpire designates an umpire to act as the Deputy Chief, the higher rate is not payable.
- 1.4 The fees payable are as follows:

| Number of days racing | Umpire Fee | Chief/Deputy Chief Umpire Fee |
|-----------------------|------------|-------------------------------|
| 3 days                | €425       | €625                          |
| 4 days                | €510       | €750                          |
| 5 days                | €595       | €875                          |
| 6 days                | €680       | €1000                         |
| 7 days                | €765       | €1125                         |
| 8 days                | €850       | €1250                         |

- 1.5 Fees are paid gross to International Umpires and it is the responsibility of the umpire to handle his or her own tax affairs.
