A submission from the Chair of the Racing Rules Committee

Purpose or Objective

Clarify a potential conflict in the existing rule.

Proposal

Change rule C2.9 regarding rule 18.2(c) to:

18.2(c) If a boat obtained an inside *overlap* and, from the time the *overlap* began, the outside boat is unable to give *mark-room*, she is not required to give it rule 18.2(a) does not apply.

Current Position

As above

Reasons

- 1. The Match racing Rules Working Party have considered this call and propose this submission.
- 2. In the current language the rule still gives an inside boat the entitlement to mark-room while then providing the outside boat the ability to not give that mark-room. This may result in rule 43.1(b) applying in a way not intended.
- 3. This wording makes it clear that in the instance of a last minute overlap, the inside boat is not entitled to mark-room.
