### Purpose or Objective

Make the rule clearer to understand.

## <u>Proposal</u>

Change rule C6.1 and C6.2 to:

- **C6.1** A boat may protest another boat
  - (a) under a rule of Part 2, except rule 14, by clearly displaying flag Y immediately after an incident in which she was involved;
  - (b) under any rule not-listed protestable in rule C6.1(a) or C6.2 by clearly displaying a red flag as soon as possible after the incident.
- **C6.2** A boat may not protest another boat under
  - (a) rule 14, unless if no damage or injury results;
  - (b) a rule of Part 2, unless she was involved in the incident;
  - (c) rule 31 or 42; or
  - (d) rule C4 or C7.

- 1. The Match racing Rules Working Party have considered this issue and propose this submission.
- 2. Assists sailors understanding of what can be protested and how this is protested.
