

Regulation 10

Timeline to inform World Sailing of the date of next World Championship

A submission from the Chair of the Classes Committee, International Cadet Class Association, Flying Fifteen International Class, International Formula Kite Class Association, 470 Class and 420 Class

Purpose or Objective

To adjust the timeline to notify World Sailing of the next World Championship of an international class.

Proposal

Amend Regulation 10.4(a) as follows:

register the dates for next year's major championships (world and continental) by 1 ~~August~~ **October** each year with World Sailing. No alteration in the championship dates are to be allowed after the annual World Sailing meeting without the approval of World Sailing, the host Member National Authority and the class/owners association;

Current Position

As above

Reasons

1. Most classes have their AGM (mainly at their World Championship) after the 1 August deadline.
 2. For Olympic Classes, the calendar window in the World Sailing Event Strategy for World Championships is September to December
 3. A 1 October deadline is therefore more realistic to achieve for classes in order to discuss / approve their World Championship at their AGM.
 4. In modern times with the use of email instead of mail, a 1 October deadline still allows the board to review the list of World Championships of the Federation and discuss/approve at their board meetings prior and at the annual conference.
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
