

WORLD SAILING POLICY REGISTER
THE POLICY REGISTER - PRINCIPLES

1. Purposes

- 1.1 The purpose of this policy is to regulate and explain the Policy Register and provide the framework for how it operates.
- 1.2 This policy furthers the objects of World Sailing by explaining how World Sailing carries out its functions as the world governing body of the sport of Sailing.
- 1.3 This policy furthers the World Sailing Strategic Plan by requiring that policies adopted by World Sailing are consistent with its objects and the Strategic Plan itself.

2. Commencement

- 2.1 This policy commences from 9 November 2024.

3. Interpretation

- 3.1 Words and phrases defined in the Constitution and Regulations have the same meaning as in those documents.
- 3.2 The following words and phrases have the following meanings:
 - (a) “policy” means a mandatory statement of the principles guiding the World Sailing’s operations and decision-making.
 - (b) “Responsible Committee” means the committee(s) set out in each Policy as the responsible committee(s).

4. Policy

- 4.1 Further to Article 22.3(c), the Board must publish and maintain a register of all World Sailing policies made after November 2012 (“the Register”).
- 4.2 World Sailing’s operations and decision-making must be managed in accordance with World Sailing Policy as set out in the Register.
- 4.3 The Board, on the recommendation of the Responsible Committee as defined in a Policy, may make binding procedures which must be followed in implementing a Policy.
- 4.4 The Responsible Committee may issue non-binding guidelines for the implementation of a Policy.
