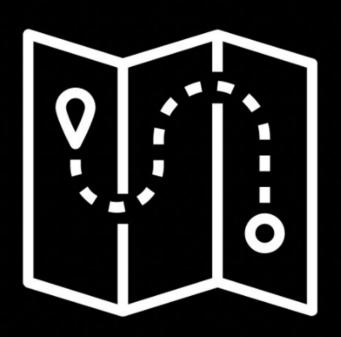
Policy & Consulting
