This is direct instruction what to do.







#### Governmental:

- a) local level.
- b) regional level.
- c) national level
- d) international level.

## Local & regional

Towns/Cities

• Regions/ Voivodeships/ Marshals etc.

Seek funding from every level of government. If there is no money for sports, try to get funds for promotion (!) or cover other organizational costs.

If there is no money, ask for non-financial organizational support.



**EXAMPLE - PYA EVENTS:**

- Polish Nationals
  - PYA CUP

## National

- Different (!) Ministries.
- Agencies.
- Institutes.
- Foundations.

Look for financial resources for sports, institutional development, equipment, innovations, culture, organization of any task that can be combined with sailing, etc.

## Important (!)

- a) Learn about particular project (manual/instruction etc.)
- b) If evaluation card is published oraz even information about evaluation criteria you have to cover all areas influencing a postive assessment! e.g. volunteers, X % own funds, resources etc.
- c) If there is list of goals you need to put all of them streight into the application or at least paraphrase them!
- d) If conditions are published you have to fulfill them one by one.
- e) Apply for patronage (if there is no conflict of interest).
- f) Method, date and place of submitting applications you have preciselly follow.

These are formal applications so there are absolutely no excuses for the formal side of the application!



## International

Add) international – e.g. European Commission

• Erasmus+

EU programme for education, training, youth and sport.

• Erasmus+ actions in the field of sport promote participation in sport, physical activity, and voluntary activities.

### Erasmus +

Sport actions are designed to tackle societal and sport-related challenges.

#### Four calls /actions:

- 1. Cooperation Partnerships / min. 3 different organisations from min. 3 different Programme Countries.
- 2. Small-scale Partnerships. /\*recommended for the "beginners".
- 3. Not-for-profit European Sport Events. /Three types (3-5, min. 6, min. 10).
- 4. Capacity Building in the field of sport. / EU Members and third countries associated to the Programme and the Western Balkans.

## How to start?

- a) Learn about the Erasmus + program: LINK
- b) Create EU account: LINK
- c) Register organization (Funding & Tenders): LINK

#### You need to have a PIC /OID number!

- d) Find the partnership or work at your own proposal.
- e) Choose or find/hire an expert (!). \*The proces is demending.
- f) Find and talk to/consult with the E+ coordinator in your country /e.g. POL-FRSE: LINK

## General comments:

- a) We need to Keep mission and goal always in front of us.
- b) Human resources Fundraisers (Employees/ Volunteers/ Outsourcing).
- c) Constant research.
- d) Find the source first, check if you can appy for it from the formal side and then try to match the source to your target.
- e) When you write the application **try to help experts** on the other side to evaluate our application properly! By the covering in content all the requirements.
- f) For most of the funders, **combining sources** is allowed and recommended.
- g) Submit your application on time and very carefully with instruction.
- h) Own project evaluation e.g. PDCA cycle.

3. Apply. Try and ... keep trying.
