







# **Notice to Competitors**

#### Classification

Ahead of the World Sailing Inclusion Championships, please read the following important information regarding classification appointments.

#### 1. Do You Need Classification?

If you are competing in Para, Visual, Cognitive, or Intellectual Impairment categories and you have an impairment affecting your sailing performance, you will need to undergo classification.

# 2. You MUST Bring the Following Documents:

To be classified, you must bring printed and digital copies of:

- Completed Medical Diagnostics Form (MDF)
- Medical evidence dated within the last 12 months
- Imaging (MRI, CT, X-ray) if relevant
- Ophthalmology/optometry reports for VI (including visual acuity + field tests)
- Neuropsychological or cognitive assessments for CI/II (if available)
- Psychological assessments or educational reports for II (if applicable)
- Assistive devices used when sailing (orthotics, seating, straps, etc.)
- Passport or ID

Please ensure all paperwork is complete - missing documents may delay or prevent classification.

## 3. Booking Your Appointment

### All sailors must pre-book their classification appointment.
